Guidelines for reimbursement/settlement of Ayurvedic treatment expenditure claims under insurance coverage.

Following benchmarks for insurance coverage of Ayurvedic treatment may be applicable for settlement/reimbursement of insurance claims.

1. Eligible hospitals for Ayurvedic treatment-

a) Central or state Government hospitals

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- b) NABH accredited Ayurvedic hospitals
- c) Teaching hospitals attached to Ayurvedic colleges recognized by Central Government/ Central Council of Indian Medicine
- d) Ayurvedic hospitals having registration with a Government Authority under appropriate Act in a State/UT, minimum fifteen beds, minimum five qualified and registered Ayurvedicdoctors, adequate number of qualified paramedical staff, dedicated Ayurveda therapy sections and daily maintenance of medical records.
